



News from Friendship Force International

Friendship Force International has announced the appointment of Jeremi Snook as the sixth President and CEO, effective November 9, 2015. Jeremi has a Master's degree in Business Administration and has experience working as a senior executive in the non-profit sector as well as experience starting a small business that earned him and his partner the Top 50 Fastest Growing Companies award. His work experience includes the United Way and most recently as Chief Operating Officer with the Spaulding Youth Center in Northfield, New Hampshire.

The building in Atlanta, which currently houses the FFI office, is being converted into a hotel so the office is relocating. The Board of Directors is acquiring a new website/data management system, which will necessitate months of installation and data re-entry over the October-March 2016 period. The new data management costs \$40,000 and FFI has asked for donations. Our club sent a \$250 donation in October to help assist in updating their data management system.
